#### From Auckland's city centre

Take the Southern Motorway and exit via the Redoubt Road off ramp. Turn right on Redoubt Road. Turn left on Great South Road. The centre is 700m to your left.

#### From Papakura

Take Southern Motorway and exit 449A-B for Great South Road. Turn left on Great South Road (signs for Manurewa). The centre is 400m to your left.

Entry to parking via gate 3. Parking is complimentary for event attendees.
